Does the participation in this phase I make the bidder ineligible to offer technical assistance in the second phase?</i></p>	<p>Basically, the winner of the bid in Phase-I, should have the priority to bid the Phase-II. However, MRC Secretariat including the 4-member countries will strictly evaluate the performance from Phase-I basis.</p> <p>So, it depends on the winner bidder's performance and the outputs of Phase-I before considering to the Phase-II.</p>

If a language test needs to be taken, is it possible to show compliance by the expert team members after submitting a winning proposal?</i></p>	<p>This requirement based on the MRC’s rule. The bidder team must have <i>TOIEC score > 600 required except for those who have PhD from English Native Speaking Countries</i>. However, the team who graduated from International Uni/Institute are also met this requirement.</p>
